Pathfinder Irrigation District Announces increase in the water allocation.

Mitchell, Nebraska, July 20, 2021: The Pathfinder Irrigation District announces an increase in its water allocation. With recent gains the District is able to increase the allocation from 1.5 acre-feet/acre to 1.6 acre-feet/acre.

The District will also begin to cut deliveries to 90% of its normal rates to help stretch out the water supply. Irrigators are asked to work with District staff to make these cuts. Base on the current supply and water usage levels the District anticipates being able to operate until sometime in the first week of September, provided usage levels remain the same. Irrigators are encouraged to place their water orders 48 hours in advance to help the District manage the water supply as efficiently as possible.
