Pathfinder Irrigation District Announces Early Season Irrigation Deliveries

Mitchell, Nebraska, May 8, 2019: The Pathfinder Irrigation District will begin delivering water starting on May 13, 2019, for early season irrigation.

At this time, the District anticipates having water available for delivery until about the end of May, depending on demand and water levels in the lakes. Once the Inland Lakes reach operating levels deliveries will terminate for early irrigation.

Irrigators wishing to draw water during the early season should contact their ditchrider and place their order. A list of ditchrider contact information can be found on the District's website at www.pathfinderirrigation.com under the Directory Tab at the top of the home page, or by calling the Mitchell Office at 308-623-1022.

Information concerning water operations will also be sent via text messaging. The District has developed the contact information for irrigators to allow for mass text messaging. If you did not receive a text message from Pathfinder on May 8, 2019 and would like to receive text messages from the District please contact Rick Miller at 308-623-1022 to assist in adding your contact information to our list.

The Bureau of Reclamation is currently projecting a full water supply for 2019. Should conditions change the District will adjust its plans accordingly. While the water supply outlook is adequate, irrigators are encouraged to work with the District to manage and conserve as much water as possible.
